- 3. Ask your host institution to sign your Learning Agreement
- 4. Scan and email your Learning Agreement to international@bio.uni-frankfurt.de
- 5. In case of any changes to the original *Learning Agreement* please seek approval of the new programme at the Host Institution and with the responsible at the Faculty of Bioscience
